Bodh Gaya is home to Mahabodhi Temple, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and several other notable temples and monasteries. Nestled in Bodh Gaya is the iconic 80 ft. statue of Buddha and Indosan Nippon temple that was constructed in 1972 and has a gallery of Japanese art.

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APPLICATION PROCEDURE

APPLICATION PROCESS

Application process will begin after receiving nominations with student details (first name, last name, valid email address, current programme that the student is enrolled in at the partner school, and level of study) from the student exchange coordinator of the partner school. The International Relations Office will reach out to the nominated students with application form and other details.

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED

Nominated students are required to send the following documents via email to the International Relations Office at (ir.office@iimbg.ac.in)

- Duly Filled application form
- Brief resume along with two passport-size photographs. The latest transcript from the home school.
- Official nomination letter from home institute's exchange office
- A health certificate stating that student does not carry any infectious disease.
- Photocopy of Passport and Visa
- An undertaking duly signed by the student and forwarded by the student exchange coordinator at the partner school.

Note: Since the principle objective of the exchange program is to increase the cultural diversity of the campus, the exchange program is not open to students holding an Indian Passport.

LANGUAGE REQUIREMENT

English is the language of instruction and assessment at IIM Bodh Gaya. Thus, incoming students are expected to hold adequate levels of English speaking, reading, and writing skills.

VISA REQUIREMENTS

IIM BG issues a Visa letter to the students based on which the Students have to get their visas from the Indian Embassy in their countries. Please note: Students are expected to arrive only on a student visa. The institute will not be in a position to provide documentary or another form of support for students traveling on visas of any other type. IIM BG does not entertain any undertaking or financial guarantee for stay in India or renewal of residence permit.

HEALTH INSURANCE

The exchange students should have health insurance that covers worldwide for a minimum of INR 2,00,000/-

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ACADEMIC INFORMATION

ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS

1. The curriculum of the first three years of IPM includes courses on basic concepts of mathematics, economics, social sciences, psychology, financial management, IT, and organisation behaviour along with courses on physical training and mental health.
2. Students have an option to select from a range of elective courses in the final semester to determine their domain of expertise.
3. The objective is to provide an indepth comprehensive knowledge in their domain of interests which resonate with the latest industry trends and challenges.
4. The courses and electives are reviewed every year in synchronisation with the existing batch preferences and the latest and foreseeable business scenarios to achieve a relevant curriculum.
5. An emphasis on case study based, project driven, and research-oriented curriculum help shape industry ready managers who are equipped to deal with challenges that emerge in various managerial role.

GRADING SYSTEM

Students will be graded on a 10-point scale as follows:

ACCOMMODATION AND OTHER COSTS

ACCOMMODATION EXPENSES

IIM Bodh Gaya offers on-campus accommodation in single rooms equipped with all modern facilities. If on-campus rooms are unavailable, IIM Bodh Gaya will provide assistance to students in locating suitable accommodations near the campus.

Sample costs for on-campus housing:

1. Hostel, single occupancy (dorm) room rent and service charge/term: ₹12,500/-
2. Students' mess per month (Vegetarian food): ₹ 5000/-
3. Students' mess per month (Non-vegetarian food plan): ₹5000/-

OTHER EXPENSES

No costs are involved as the tuition fee is paid at their home institution. Any expenses incurred on student activities such as printing, and photocopy will be borne by the student. All dues have to be cleared before students leave the campus. Students will be required to pay monetary compensation if they are found liable for damaging the property of IIM Bodh Gaya.
