Step 1: **NOMINATION**

Eligibility

- Home institution nomination
- Undergraduate student currently enrolled at a Rice partner institution
- At time of applying, one full academic year already completed at home institution
- Minimum GPA 3.00 on 4.00 scale (or equivalent)
- In good academic and judicial standing
- Demonstrated English language proficiency

Required if the language of instruction in the student's country of origin is not English (even if the language of instruction at the home university is English).

- Minimum acceptable **TOEFL** iBT score: **100**
- Minimum acceptable **IELTS** score: **7**
- Minimum acceptable **Duolingo** score: **130**

Coursework

- Maximum: 15 (-18) credits

Not available to exchange students

Courses in the Shepherd School of Music and the School of Architecture are not available to exchange students unless they are offered specifically to non-major undergraduates.

Courses available to exchange students

Provided that pre-requisites for courses are met, all undergraduate courses in the Schools of Engineering, Natural Sciences, Social Sciences, Humanities and Business are open to exchange students. Enrollment in desired courses cannot be guaranteed and will always be subject to availability in terms of course capacity and scheduling restraints. Course registration is completed during orientation.
